The district is served by three major U.S. Highways, nine primary state highways, and numerous state secondary highways. No interstate highways pass through the district. U.S. 19 is a major north-south highway that runs from Erie, Pennsylvania to St. Petersburg, Florida; U.S. 460 is an east-west highway that runs from Norfolk, Virginia to St. Louis, Missouri; and U.S. 58 is an east-west highway that runs from Norfolk, Virginia to Middlesboro, Kentucky.

State primary and secondary highways provide intra-district access, as well as access to points in neighboring counties and West Virginia and Kentucky.
